Charles Tegeler, M.D, Director of the Comprehensive Stroke Center at Wake Forest University Baptist Medical Center (WFUBMC), is Vice President of the North Carolina Stroke Association (NCSA). In addition, he is Director of the WFUBMC Telestroke Network, which partners with community hospitals in 24 counties in western North Carolina and southern Virginia to provide access to acute stroke experts.

A faculty member of the Wake Forest University School of Medicine since 1990, Dr. Tegeler is a McKinney-Avant Professor of Neurology and Head of the Section on Stroke, Cerebrovascular Disease and Neurosonology within the Department of Neurology. He is a nationally recognized expert on stroke and the use of ultrasound for risk identification and prevention of stroke and cardiovascular disease, and has been instrumental in the development and analysis of NCSA's successful Stroke Risk Identification Program. Dr. Tegeler consults with hospitals and organizations statewide on the importance of stroke prevention and education initiatives.

Dr. Tegeler has served as President of the American Society of Neuroimaging and is the immediate Past-President of the North Carolina Neurological Society. Additional appointments include Chair of the Neuroimaging Section of the American Academy of Neurology and the Executive Committee of the Neurosonology Research Group of the World Federation of Neurology.
